The Village may require additional information be submitted to ensure that all Village requirements are being met. The Applicant will be contacted, if additional information is required to be submitted.

SPORTS COURT REQUIREMENTS *A Sports Court is defined as a hard surface where its primary purpose is to play basketball, tennis, shuffleboard or other such sport or activity. A residential driveway shall not be considered a sport court and does not require a Sports Court Permit.*

Pursuant to Article XIII of Chapter 420 of the Village Municipal Code no person shall construct, repair, replace, install, enlarge, or alter any residential sports court unless a valid permit has first been issued pursuant to the following requirements.

- One sport court is allowed per property.
- The sport court shall be located in the side or rear property yard, provided that such court is 10 feet from the property line and not located within any easements.
- All sport courts over 1,200 square feet shall be required to have a ten-foot-high heavy-duty sport net or a fence surrounding the court. A Fence Permit is required for any new fence or modification to an existing fence.
- If any sport court is proposed to be illuminated, such lights shall be directed downward and shielded so as not to shine or cause a glare onto adjacent properties and/or roadways and a Residential Electrical Permit is required.

PERMIT REVIEW AND ISSUANCE OF PERMIT

- Permits may require up to 10 business days to process. If during the Village's review of the application, information is missing or additional information is required, then permit will be put on hold until the information is received and the 10-day review period will start again. The Applicant will be contacted when the permit is ready to be issued with total permit fees due and permit conditions. It is the responsibility of the applicant to provide a copy of the permit conditions to the contractor/owner.
- Before digging call Diggers Hotline at 1-800-982-0299 to have all underground utilities marked.

INSPECTIONS

All required inspections shall be scheduled at least 2 business days in advance by calling 262.925.6726 with the permit number.

REQUIRED SIGNATURES

By submitting this application, I certify that all of the information and attachments submitted are true and correct to the best of my knowledge. I understand that for any work started or completed without proper permits, a triple fee will be charged. I agree that all of the work will be done in accordance with all applicable Village, County, State and Federal codes, ordinance requirements and permit conditions. I also agree to allow the inspection of the premises by the Village's Inspectors during regular business hours.
