MINIMUM SUBMITTAL REQUIREMENTS		
	Project Plan that explains the project. At a minimum a site plan illustrating the project and the location of materials to be removed/planted. Site photographs. The Village may require that all materials proposed to be removed be flagged on site.	
	Permit/approval from the WI DNR, if applicable	
	Permit/approval from the US ACOE, if applicable	

The Village may require additional information be submitted to ensure that all Village requirements are being met. The Applicant will be contacted if additional information is required to be submitted.

REVIEW AND APPROVAL POCEEDURE

- Upon receipt of a complete application, the Village will prepare the required 20-day notice to property owners within 200 feet of the property, the WI DNR, US ACOE and SEWRPC.
- After the 20-day review period, the Village shall approve or deny the application. If the application is approved the owner must agree to the stipulations prior to the issuance of the permit and the stipulations shall be recorded at the Kenosha County Register of Deeds Office.
- A stipulated conservancy permit may be for valid for up to two years with a renewal of said permit only if the management/restoration plan has not been changed or altered in any manner.

INSPECTIONS AND CERTIFICATIONS

- Village staff may conduct inspections of the property during the project, depending upon the scope of the work.
- A Certification Letter shall be provided by the contractor to the Village to certify that the project was completed pursuant to this application and approved permit conditions.

REQUIRED CONTACT INFORMATION AND SIGNATURES

By submitting this application, I certify that all of the information and attachments submitted are true and correct to the best of my knowledge. I understand that for any work started or completed without proper permits, a triple fee will be charged. I agree that all of the work will be done in accordance with all applicable Village, County, State and Federal codes, ordinance requirements and permit conditions. I also agree to allow any inspections of the premises by the Village's Inspectors during regular business hours.
