



WIS 50 Project Update

117TH TO 43RD AVENUES RECONSTRUCTION

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is beginning the WIS 50 reconstruction project between 117th and 43rd avenues. Work is scheduled to begin in early February 2021, with a scheduled completion of early 2023. Highlights of the project are provided below.

PROJECT OVERVIEW:

- Expand the roadway to a 6-lane concrete roadway between 117th and 57th avenues
- Reconstruct the existing 4-lane roadway between 57th and 43rd avenues
- Implement access management measures, including driveway and median modifications
- Provide additional vehicle capacity at local road intersections
- Add sidewalk and bicycle accommodations throughout the project
- Two lanes of traffic will be maintained in each direction during construction

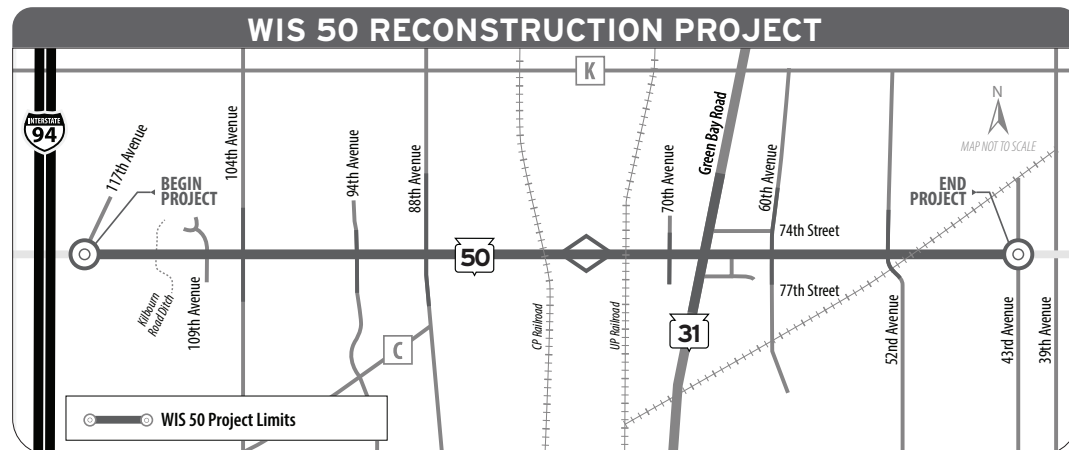
THE FOLLOWING WORK IS SCHEDULED TO TAKE PLACE IN 2021:

117th Avenue to 88th Avenues:

- Construct eastbound and westbound lanes
- Construct a new intersection at WIS 50 and 109th Avenue

88th Avenue to 70th Avenues:

- Bridge improvements at Union Pacific Railroad, Canadian Pacific Railroad, and 77th Avenue
- Construct retaining wall and ponds near WIS 50 and WIS 31 intersection
- Service interchange at 77th Avenue
- Traffic switch to bi-directional traffic on eastbound lanes end of 2021
- Westbound work to begin late 2021/early 2022
