WIS 50 Reconstruction | 117th to 43rd avenues | Kenosha

EASTBOUND WIS 50 TO CLOSE OVERNIGHT

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with reconstructing WIS 50 (75th Street), between 117th and 43rd avenues in Kenosha County. The following work is scheduled for the next phase of this project.

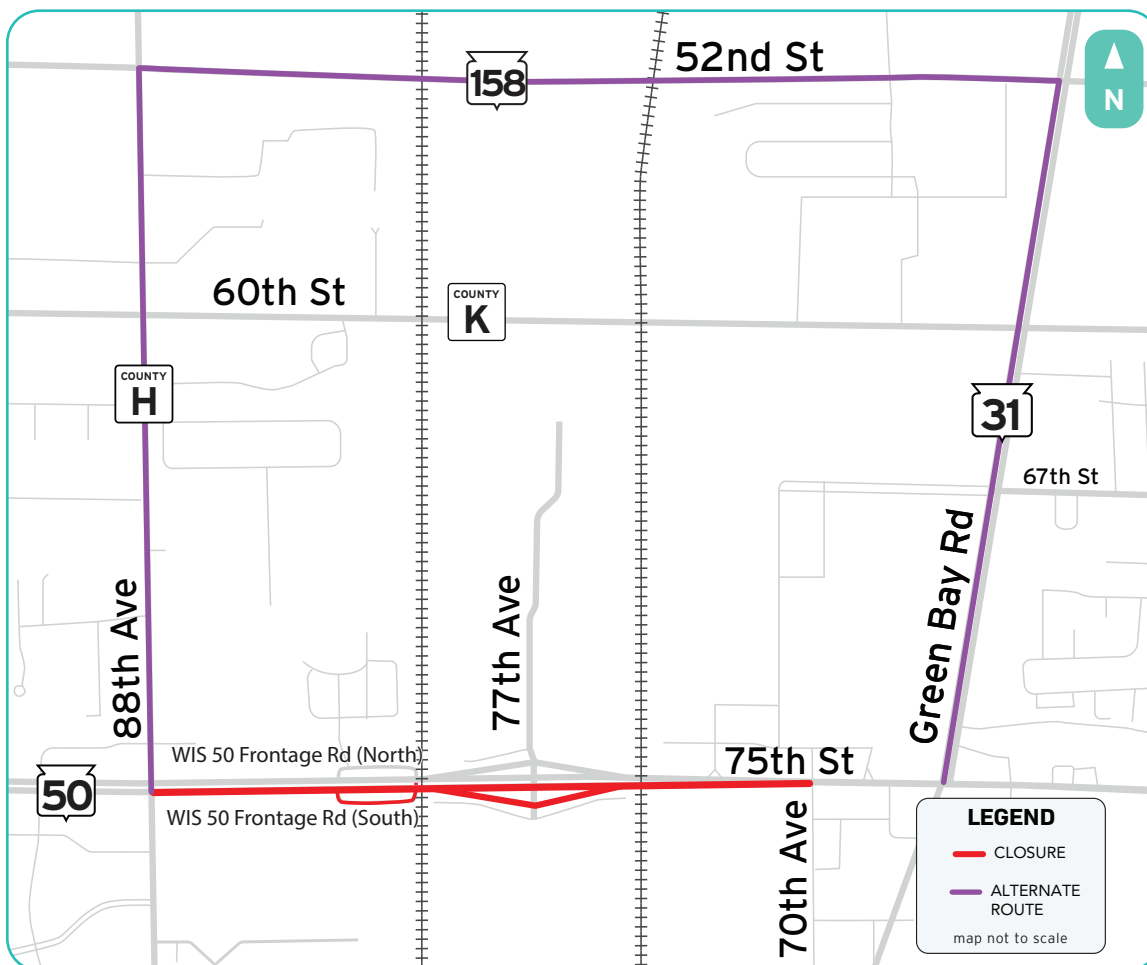
Tuesday, May 11:

- Eastbound WIS 50 (75th Street) from 88th Avenue (County H) to 70th Avenue is scheduled to close overnight on Tuesday, May 11 from 11 p.m. to 6 a.m. for crane mobilization.

Alternate Route:

Motorists are encouraged to utilize 88th Avenue (County H), WIS 158 (52nd Street), and WIS 31 (Green Bay Road) to get around this single night closure.

Access to residences and businesses will be maintained during this closure



The speed limit on WIS 50 has been reduced to 40 mph from 117th Avenue to 70th Avenue.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
