## 99TH AVENUE TO CLOSE OVERNIGHT

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with reconstructing WIS 50 (75th Street), between 117th and 43rd avenues in Kenosha County. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project.

### Beginning Monday June 7:

- 99th Avenue from WIS 50 (75th Street) to 76th Street is scheduled to close overnight, between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m., for approximately two nights for storm sewer crossings.

### Alternate Route:

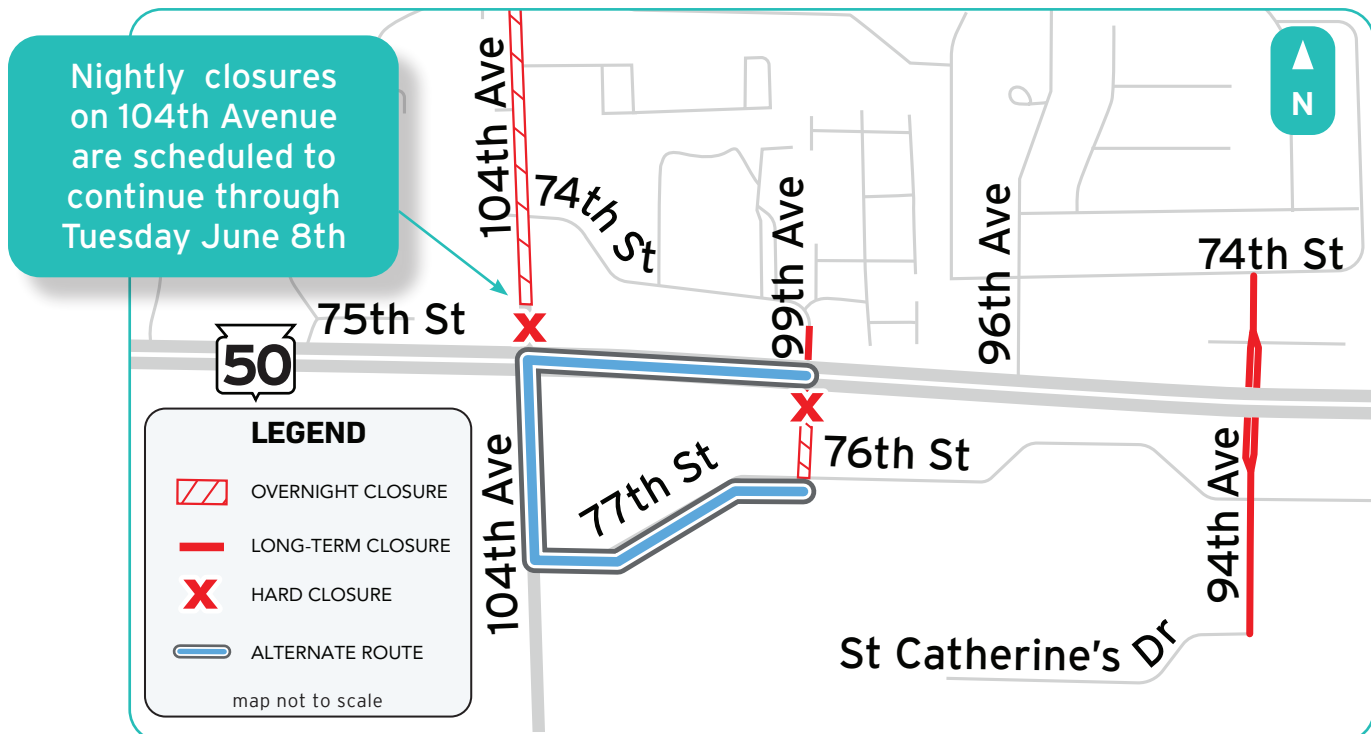
- Motorists are encouraged to utilize WIS 50 (75th Street), 104th Avenue, and 77th/76th Street to get around this closure.

Access to residences and businesses will be maintained during this closure



The speed limit on WIS 50 will be reduced during construction to 40 mph from 117th Avenue to 70th Avenue.
