## 88TH AVENUE (COUNTY H) TO CLOSE OVERNIGHT

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with reconstructing WIS 50 (75th Street), between 117th and 43rd avenues in Kenosha County. The following work is scheduled to take place as part of this project.

### Wednesday June 30th

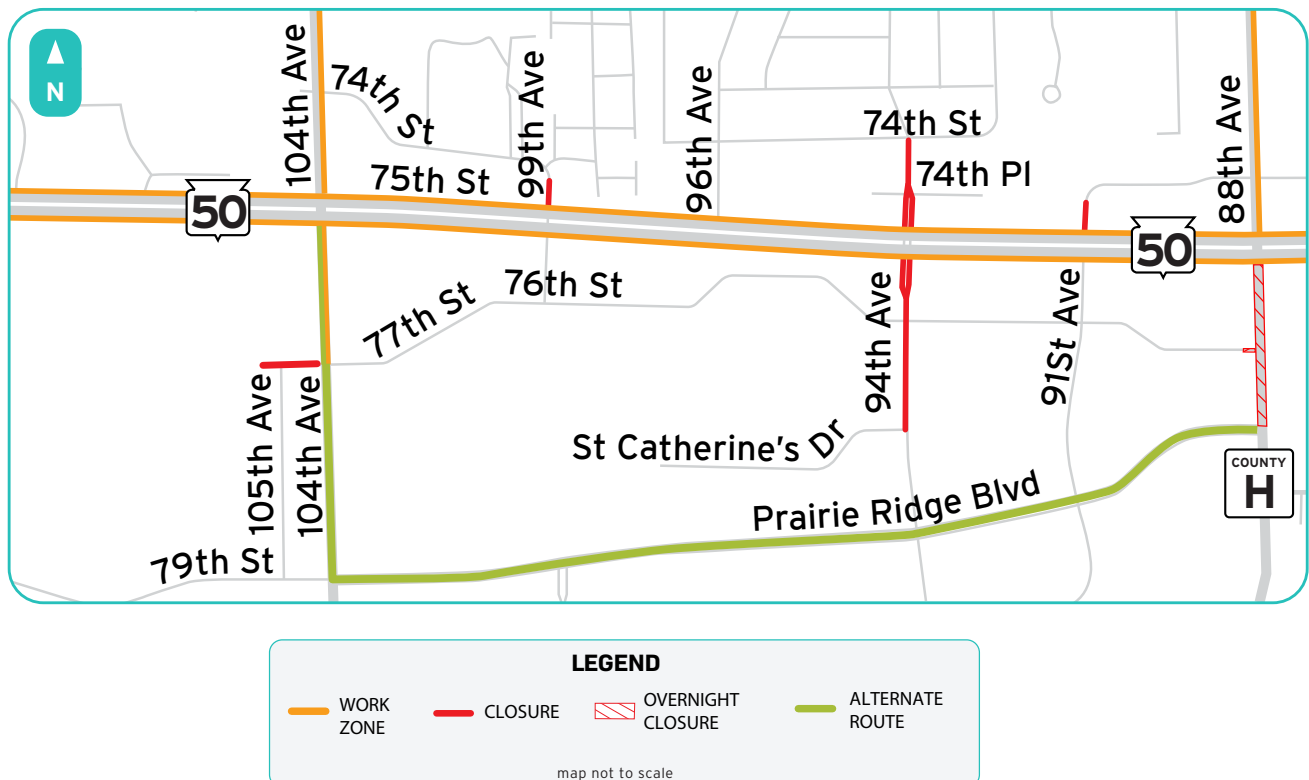
- 88th Avenue (County H) from WIS 50 (75th Street) to Prairie Ridge Boulevard is scheduled to close overnight, between 10 p.m. and 6 a.m., for storm sewer operations.

### Alternate Route:

- Motorists are encouraged to use 104th Avenue and Prairie Ridge Boulevard to get around this closure.

Access to residences and businesses will be maintained during this closure.
