OVERNIGHT EASTBOUND WIS 50 CLOSURES

The Wisconsin Department of Transportation (WisDOT) is underway with reconstructing WIS 50 (75th Street), between 117th and 43rd avenues in Kenosha County. The following work is scheduled for the next phase of this project.

Monday October 11 and Tuesday October 12:

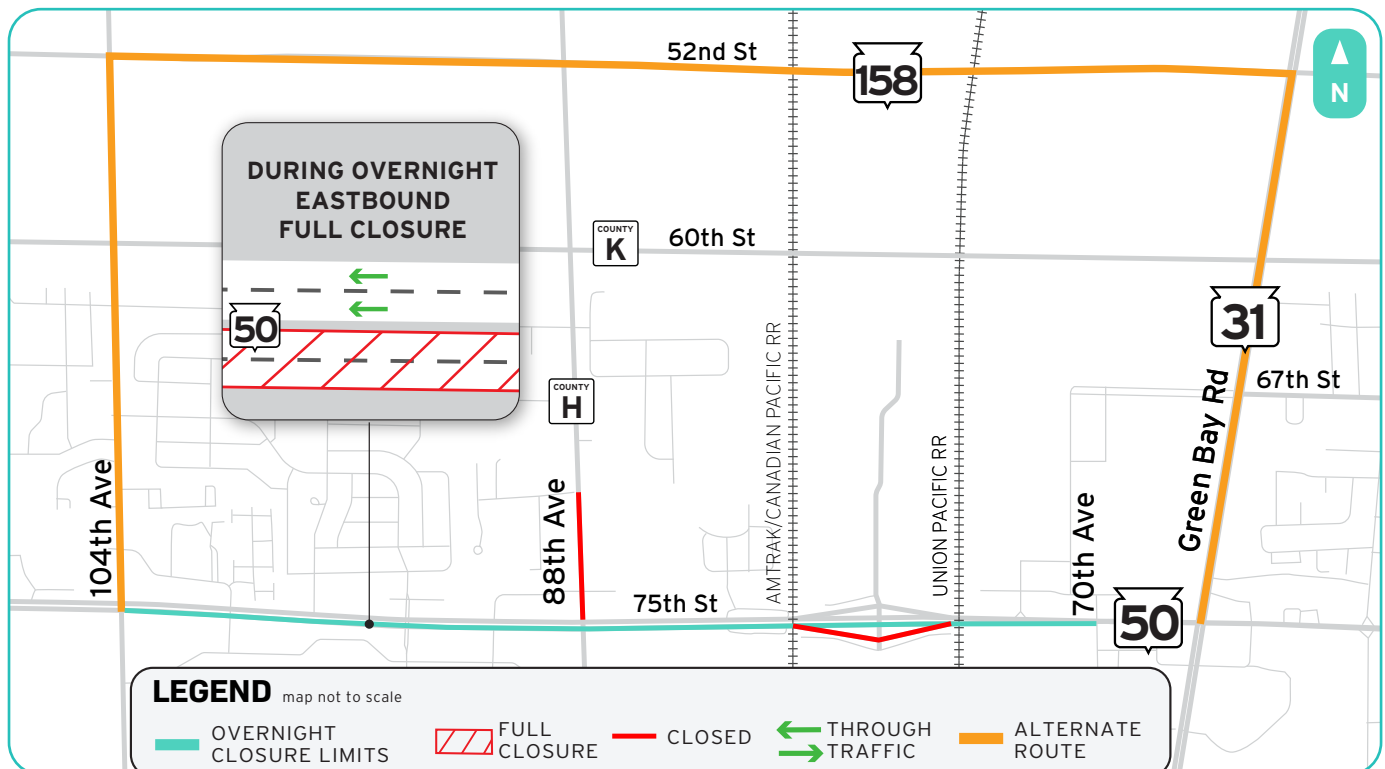
- Eastbound WIS 50, between 104th Avenue and 70th Avenue is scheduled to be closed overnight from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m., for bridge demolition.

Alternate Route:

→ Motorists are encouraged to use 104th Avenue, 52nd Street (WIS 158), and Green Bay Road (WIS 31) to get around the closure.

Access to residences and businesses will be maintained throughout construction.

Please note that all work is weather dependent and subject to change.
