Job Summary

The Parks Maintenance Worker reports directly to the Parks Crew Leader; under the general supervision of the Director of Public Works who serves as the department head. The Parks Maintenance Worker position functions primarily in the Parks Division. The primary responsibility of this position is to maintain the green spaces, landscape, and parks within the Village of Pleasant Prairie.

Job Duties

Maintenance 4 Worker FT45 (hourly rate \$21.98 - \$27.48)

- Must be able to interact effectively and cheerfully with the public.
- Must have the ability to effectively communicate with co-workers and the public.
- Must be able to maintain and prepare athletic playing fields for Village recreation programs.
- Must be able to operate chain saw, small tractor, sandpro, lawnmower, weed trimmer, hedge trimmer, roto-tiller, bed edger, and brush chipper.
- Must be able to use manual maintenance equipment such as a shovel, rake, hoe, pole saw, broom, etc. for an extended period of time.
- Ability to safely drive a pickup truck with a trailer attached forward and backward.
- Ability to plant flowers, shrubs, and trees.
- Must be able to work independently or as a team.
- Must be able to assist Highway Department in winter months completing maintenance and plowing snow.
- Must be able to perform minor maintenance on trucks (flat, oil change, etc.).
- Must be able to work on a ladder.

Maintenance 3 Worker FT42 (hourly rate \$24.27 - \$30.31)

- Must be familiar with the location of Village parks, sewer stations and lift stations.
- Must have or be able to obtain at least a Class B Wisconsin Commercial Driver's License (CDL) within one year.
- Ability to prune, fertilize, edge, mulch, and apply weed killer to Village landscaping.
- Assist Village crews in snowplow operations.
- Operate skidsteer and chipper within Village owned property.
- Must be able to obtain and maintain a Wisconsin turf and landscape category 3.0 Chemical Applicator License.
- Must have skills and knowledge relating to turf and landscape management.

Maintenance 2 Worker FT35 (hourly rate \$26.49 - \$33.12)

- Must be able to use a commercial fogger for mosquito abatement.
- Must have or be able to obtain at least a Class B with combination Wisconsin Commercial Driver's License (CDL)
- Education with specialty in Horticulture or related field.
- Completion of Landscaping and Grounds Short Course program.
- Must be able to obtain and maintain a Wild Land Firefighter Training Certification.
- Must be knowledgeable of automated lawn sprinkler systems.

Physical Requirements

- Ability to work outside for an extended period of time, in areas of noxious odors, in wet or muddy areas, and able to tolerate fluctuations in temperature while performing duties.
- Essential job functions of this position require a significant amount of standing, walking, sitting, pushing, pulling, stooping, crouching, kneeling, reaching, climbing and lifting and carrying a range of weight up to 100 pounds.

- Must be 18 years or older; with a valid drivers license.
- Regular scheduled hours will vary.
- Occasional evening and weekend work is required.
