Job Title Sanitation Maintenance Worker (Levels I - III)

Classification Hourly/Non-exempt \$23.93/hr. - \$36.28/hr.

Job Summary

The Sanitation Maintenance Worker is a full-time, technical, field position in the Department of Public Works and reports to the Sanitation Crew Lead. The primary responsibility of this position is to effectively and efficiently collect Solid Waste, Recycling and heavy manual labor of collecting refuse within the Village of Pleasant Prairie as outlined below. Hours are 6:15 a.m. to 2:15 p.m., 5 days a week. Workdays may fluctuate with some weekend, holiday, and overtime work required

Job Duties

Sanitation Maintenance Worker - Level I \$23.93/hr. - \$26.27/hr. PW17

- Utilizes a PC based computer to monitor work orders, record work, and generate various reports.
- Utilizes sanitation maintenance equipment including, but not limited to, garbage truck side-load, garbage truck rear-load, and snow plow equipment.
- Performs minor maintenance on vehicles.
- Utilizes safe practices and takes protective measures as required, including wearing all applicable Personal Protective Equipment (PPE).
- Follows all Village policies and procedures, and Village codes and ordinances.
- Performs other duties and special assignments as directed within the scope of the Public Works Department.

Sanitation Maintenance Worker – Level II \$27.15/hr. - \$29.85/hr. PW14 In addition to Level I

- Familiar with the operations, objectives and equipment of sanitation maintenance activities and projects.
- Operations equipment for sanitation maintenance activities, including, but not limited to, chainsaw, brush chipper, and Vac truck.
- Effectively and safely drives and operates a single and tandem axle refuse truck.
- Participates in required on-site training and obtains Competent Person Certification.
- Cross trains in other Public Works departments and assists with a variety of projects.

Sanitation Maintenance Worker – Level III \$32.25/hr. - \$36.28/hr. PW11 In addition to Level I & II

- Safely operates heavy equipment such as loaders and skid steers.
- Leads various sanitation and/or Village Public Works projects.

Physical Requirements

- Essential job functions of this position require a significant amount of standing, walking, sitting, pushing, pulling, stooping, crouching, kneeling, climbing, and lifting and carrying a range of weight up to 100 pounds.
- Must be capable of physically demanding work in inclement weather for an extended period of time and in areas of
 noxious odors and smells, in wet or muddy areas, work in close proximity to loud and moving equipment and work in
 an environment where the noise level is usually moderately loud.
- Must have the ability to recognize possible exposure to carcinogenic dusts such as asbestos, toxic substances such
 as carbon monoxide, gases such as methane and hydrogen sulfate, or organic solvents either through inhalation or
 skin contact.
- Frequent public interaction which requires the ability to communicate information and ideas so others will understand.
 Must be able to exchange accurate information in these situations.

- High School Diploma or equivalent.
- Valid Commercial Driver's License Class B.
- Ability to obtain First Aid-CPR Certification.
- Ability to obtain HAZWOPER Training within six (6) months of employment.
- Ability to obtain Confined Space Certification.

Requirements - educational, certifications and experience – Level II In addition to Level I

- 2+ years of experience in Public Works department or related field.
- Ability to obtain Competent Person Certification.

Requirements - educational, certifications and experience - Level III In addition to Levels I & II

- Valid Commercial Driver's License Class A.
- 4+ years of experience in Public Works department or related field.
